Dr. Geary was accepted to UofA for medical school, and was inducted to the Alpha Omega Alpha Honorary Society her junior year. She was awarded the Janet M. Glasgow Memorial Achievement Citation in 1994. After finishing Medical school at the University of Arizona, Dr. Geary completed her Dermatology residency at the University of Cincinnati, where she served as chief resident.

Her expertise includes medical dermatology with an emphasis in diagnosing and treating skin cancer. Dr. Geary has been awarded Phoenix Magazine's "Top Doc" award in 2005, and 2011-2016. Dr. Geary enjoys her time mentoring to Banner Health Systems residents



and UofA medical students. She currently holds the position of associate clinical professor at UofA. In addition to her daily practice, Dr. Geary is also an active member with both the American Academy of Dermatology and Phoenix Dermatologic Society.

Dr. Geary demonstrates a true passion for delivering excellent patient care and shows great compassion to her patients. Her goal is to help educate patients and families about skin cancer prevention and to provide thorough skin cancer examinations.

Are you experiencing Hair Loss?

Did you know that many health conditions and diseases can result in hair loss as well as improper hair care. Daily shedding is normal, but the most common cause of hair loss is hereditary thinning and baldness.



Causes of Hair Loss:

- Overuse of hair care products such as dyes, gels, sprays or relaxers can cause damage and breakage
- Excessive wear of ponytails and braids that pull on the hair
- Over shampooing, combing or brushing which can pull the hair out
- Stressful situations including major surgery, childbirth, high fever or severe infections and stress
- Poor diet including low protein or iron
- Certain medications
- A variety of diseases such as thyroid disease
- Alopecia areata, which is a type of hair loss that can affect all ages, can cause the hair to fall out in round patches

Know your Insurance



East Valley Dermatology Center accepts most major carriers but it is advised that you contact our office and your insurance carrier prior to your appointment to confirm that we accept your specific insurance plan and network.

Most patients will experience a reset of their Deductibles beginning January 1, 2017. It is important for you to know and understand your financial responsibility of any Deductibles, Co-Insurance and Co-Pays. If you need assistance in understanding these financial benefits, please contact your insurance carrier prior to your appointment.

As a reminder, Dermatology is not covered under your *preventative* benefits. An office visit and any procedures completed during your visit will be billed to your insurance and applied to any Deductibles, Co-Insurance and Co-Pays based on your individual plans. You will be required to pay your Co-Pay, if applicable, at the time of your visit. Any remaining patient responsibility will be billed to you after your insurance has processed your claim. All cosmetic/elective procedures and non-insurance visits are payable in full at the time of service.

Please verify that we have received your referral prior to your visit, if your plan requires a referral to be seen at a specialist office. We will do our best to assist in the process but it is patient responsibility to obtain their referral.


Happy New Year from the Prescription Desk!
